The Service Spec and PGD for this year has still to be released, it's due very soon. See <u>PSNC main site</u> for details There is still plenty of preparation to do to ensure each pharmacy is ready for the **GO**:

What to start this week: 2 weeks to go ...

- 1. Ensure your consultation room meets the requirements for the service. These can be seen in the PSNC <u>Guidance for Flu</u> document, section g.
- 2. Ensure your fridge meets the standards for vaccine storage and stock is ordered.
- 3. Develop a new SOP for the service taking into account:
 - the roles the team will have in providing the service
 - reviewing your working practices to ensure Flu can be built into the routine working day
 - consider using an appointment system &/or whether you will perform a walk-in service
 - the need for all staff to read, understand and sign this new SOP
- 4. Continue with your recruiting and booking as described in the week 2 communication
- 5. Did you know, our top 5% performing H&IOW contractors accounted for 22% of all the flu vaccinations last year.

5% (just 17 pharmacies) achieved over 7,000 vaccinations (22%) and 78% achieved the remaining 30,000+.

The percentage of pharmacies not providing the service last year dropped from 25% to just 10% (just 37 sites)
