





Funded clinical leadership development for community pharmacy



The NHS Leadership Academy (as part of NHS England and NHS Improvement) is working in collaboration with the Centre for Pharmacy Postgraduate Education (CPPE), to offer the Mary Seacole leadership programme to pharmacists and pharmacy technicians working in community pharmacy.

This six-month programme was developed to support healthcare professionals within the NHS, and is available to the community pharmacy workforce. It is designed to develop clinical leadership and management skills to enable pharmacy professionals to drive quality services in community pharmacy and improve the health of the patients they see.
