Independent & Supplementary Prescribing Short Course

Level 7 (postgraduate) - 30 credits – course fee £1,800

Course Overview

The programme aims to support registered Nurses, registered Midwives, and registered Allied Health Professionals to acquire the competencies for Independent and/or Supplementary Prescribing as set out in the Royal Pharmaceutical Society (2016), a competency framework for all prescribers and enabled by legislation. There is an emphasis on teaching the generic principles of safe and effective prescribing practice across the lifespan, which can be applied to all Nursing and Midwifery Council (NMC) and Health & Care Professions Council (HCPC) registrants. The curriculum provides a balance of theory and practice using a range of teaching and learning strategies.
