## **Gateway Requirements**

- 1. 20 (twenty) completed New Medicine Service (NMS) claimed for between 1/4/21 5/1/22.
- 2. A Written Patient Safety Report (including LASA learnings).
- 3. A Risk Review including the risks of missing sepsis and red flags in OTC consultations and a new entry on minimising the risk of COVID-19 transmission.
- 4. CPPE training and assessment for all registered pharmacy professionals on LASA errors, risk management and sepsis (\*these should have all been done for last year's PQS if so you don't need to do again).
