Hepatitis C Antibody Testing Service	Advanced Service	1st September 2020	New Advanced Service for point of care testing for Hepatitis C (Hep C) antibodies to people who inject drugs (PWIDs), but who haven't engaged with treatment. The service is part of NHS England and NHS Improvement's national programme to eliminate Hep C by 2025. The service specification can be found here Those wishing to provide the service will need to register on MYS.	
PQS Aspiration Payment	Pharmacy Income	14th Sept	Contractors will be able to claim an aspiration payment for PQS between 14th Sept – 9th Oct. The aspiration payment is optional, those making a claim need to do so using MYS and indicate which domains they intend to achieve before the end of the PQS declaration period.	
Christmas 2020 Saturday Dec 26 th 2020	Pharmacy Business	26th September 2020	December 26 th falls on a Saturday and therefore the Bank Holiday is Monday December 28 th NOT Saturday 26 th .
