Pandemic Delivery Service – self isolating	Advanced Service	30 <sup>th</sup> June	The Delivery Service continues for those patients that need to self isolate. Patients will need to provide their Track & Trace ID reference number as proof of eligibility. More information <a href="https://example.com/here">here</a>	
Community Pharmacy Assurance Framework CPAF	Contractual	28 <sup>th</sup> June – 24 <sup>th</sup> July	The 2021/22 CPAF screening questionnaire will be available for completion between Monday 28 June 2021 and Friday 24 July 2021 via MYS.

Local Services	Pharmacy income	By the 5 <sup>th</sup> of each month	Please claim all your locally commissioned services.	
PPE	Staff Safety	Ongoing	The Government's PPE portal is available to obtain <b>all</b> personal protective equipment (PPE); supplies are provided free of charge.  Details on accessing and ordering can be found <a href="here">here</a> See the updated PHE guidance on the use of PPE by pharmacy	
COVID 19	Contractor Support	Ongoing	Ensure you keep up to date with the national & local guidance:  PSNC – for the latest news round-up  GOV.UK – for advice for healthcare professionals  PHE – for posters and resources  LPC – for next steps, links to national information and links to local information (including testing and vaccination)
