PAAPs & spacer device use in children	The child aged between 5 to 15 has been referred to a healthcare professional for a spacer device, in line with NICE TA38.		
	The patient aged 5 years or over with asthma has been referred to a healthcare professional for a personalised asthma action plan.		
Inhaler technique checks for patients prescribed a new inhaler with asthma or COPD during the COVID-19 pandemic	The patient was identified as having been prescribed an inhaler for the first time or changed to a new inhaler device between 1st April 2020 and 31st August 2021 and has been asked if they have had an inhaler technique check during that time.		
	The patient answered no to the previous question and were offered a catch-up NMS, including an inhaler technique check.		
	The patient was subsequently provided with a <u>face-to-face</u> catch-up NMS, including an inhaler technique check.		
	The patient was subsequently provided with a <u>remote</u> catch-up NMS, including an inhaler technique check.		
	The patient was referred to their prescriber due to issues identified during the catch-up NMS.		
Return of unwanted & used inhalers	A conversation was had with the patient and/or their carer on the safe and environmentally friendly disposal of their inhaler.		
Weight management	The patient had their BMI calculated and waist circumference measured, including explanation of the definition of BMI and the potential health impact of each.		
	The patient was referred to Local Authority funded tier 2 weight management service.		
	The patient was referred to the NHS Digital Weight Management Programme (for those with hypertension and/or diabetes).
