CPCS IT	Advanced Service	Now	From the 1 <sup>st</sup> April the pharmacy needs to have organised it's IT for the delivery of the CPCS Service. The national procurement will cease at the end of March 2022. <u>Information</u>	
Mandatory Health Campaign	Contractual	28 <sup>th</sup> February – 31 <sup>st</sup> March	<b>Better Health Stop Smoking Campaign</b> : You must participate from 28 February (or as soon as you receive the materials if they arrive after this date), and the campaign runs until 31 March.	
PQS Declaration Closes	Pharmacy Income	2 <sup>nd</sup> March	The PQS declaration window will close at 11.59pm on 2 <sup>nd</sup> March.	
PQS – Anticoag Audit	Pharmacy Income	3 <sup>rd</sup> March	Deadline to start the anticoagulant audit (four weeks till 31st March 2022).	
CPSC Webinar	Information & Support	7 <sup>th</sup> March	At 8pm. The webinar aims to provide you with support and advice to help understand requirements. There will be a focus on having conversations about weight. <u>Sign up here</u>	
Smoking Cessation Service (SCS)	Advanced Service	10 <sup>th</sup> March	The Smoking Cessation Service for patients referred from hospital on discharge will be launched on the 10 <sup>th</sup> March. <u>Smoking</u> <u>cessation Service</u>	
Pharmacy Advice Audit	PSNC Support	11 <sup>th</sup> March	Record the healthcare advice that is given to patients during a single day (or until the minimum number of interactions/ consultations is reached). The results provide critical insight on how patients are relying on community pharmacy. Information here	
PQS	Pharmacy Income	31 <sup>st</sup> March	Deadline to complete the remaining PQS work (although you have until 30 <sup>th</sup> June to gather the evidence). The MYS online portal to record anticoagulant audit data closes. The PHE portal to record antibiotic review data closes.	
Pharmacy Collect	Advanced Service	31 <sup>st</sup> March	The pharmacy Collect Service will end on the 31 <sup>st</sup> March. <u>More</u> information here	
PQS Gateway - NMS	Pharmacy Income	4 <sup>th</sup> April	Make sure you have completed and claimed for a minimum 20 NMS by 5 <sup>th</sup> April (March end of month submission)	
New Medicine Service	Contractual	April 2022	Requirement to submit quarterly NMS data currently paused. Pharmacies will need to submit data for April – June in early July 2022. More information <u>here.</u>	
Healthy Living Pharmacy	Contractual	Ongoing	<b>Places available</b> - You can train up to 3 health champions per pharmacy free of charge (HEE funded). More information <u>here</u>

Pharmacy Profile Update / NHS Profiler	Contractual	Quarterly	Ensure your Directory of Services (DoS) and NHS website pharmacy* profiles are up to date and verify each quarter. Remember to update your DoS profile if you have to temporarily close during normal hours. *to be replaced by NHS Profiler during March	
Local Services	Pharmacy income	By the 5 <sup>th</sup> of each month	Please claim all your locally commissioned services.	
PPE	Staff Safety	Ongoing	A new PPE Portal will be launched during March. <u>Information here</u> This portal is available to obtain <b>all</b> personal protective equipment required for service delivery; supplies are provided free of charge. See current PHE guidance on the use of PPE by pharmacy staff
