Training Dates - Pharmacy Flu Vaccination Advanced Service 2017-2018

Hampshire & IOW and Dorset LPCs are working in partnership with the NPA to provide training and support for any pharmacist wishing to be eligible to deliver the NHS Advanced Flu Service that **all community pharmacies** are able to provide from September this year.

This training is open to all pharmacists regardless of NPA membership. Prices have been discounted from the NPA's usual tariff rate for those quoting this invitation and referencing the LPC training initiative.

Whilst the details of the PGD for this advanced service have not yet been made available, it is anticipated that it will be similar to last year and will be specific for community pharmacy.

Therefore, in order to be eligible to deliver the service, NHS England has determined that pharmacists providing the Flu Vaccination Service **you must successfully complete both an online theory-based refresher course and practical face-to-face training for both injection technique and basic life support training every two years, irrespective of how many vaccines are administered each year.**

The training covers intramuscular, subcutaneous intranasal and intradermal vaccination techniques; basic life support and anaphylaxis management.

Prices is as follows: -

Flu vaccination + private PGD (practical training) £85 +VAT
