23/05/06	<p>Professional Services Update</p> <p>A Freemantle updated the committee on her activities during the previous two months by both written and verbal reports.</p> <p>Highlights</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Oral Contraceptive Pilot – Tier 2, 60 of the 99 consultations done to date are from the HIOW patch. Pharmacies doing pop ups for over 75s and helping with patients in hospital who need to be vaccinated and who may have fallen through the cracks for covid vaccination boosters. <p>Lowlights</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pharmacy oral contraception service, lack of funding. Hampshire drug misuse service, difficult to get through to Lloyds for outstanding and missed payments. DMS claiming, Oct – Dec 2022 vs those completed on PharmOutcomes. NHS England pushing things out before supporting material is ready or sent out. <p>Oral Contraception Service</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> PSNC not promoting it. It has been very successful on the HIOW patch. The committee considered whether we should do nothing or continue with what we have done as an LPC. All members were in favour of continuing with what the LPC has done so far, taking a balanced approach and providing relevant information to contractors. We are making contractors aware of the National Negotiator’s opinion and letting the contractors make their own informed decision.
