| Pharmacy First | Pharmacy Income | October | The activity threshold of clinical pathway consultations is 20 per month for October . This means you need to provide a minimum of 20 consultations that pass the gateway point to be eligible for the £1,000 monthly payment. Action: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ensure pharmacy team members are aware of gateway criteria and discuss actions that can support the team to reach the target. | |
| Stoptober | Information & Support | October | Annual health campaign to promote quitting smoking. Resources available here. | |
| NHS Flu Vaccination Service | Pharmacy Income | 3 rd October | Pharmacies can start to vaccinate all eligible cohorts from 3 rd October. Use resources available to promote uptake. Resources here | |
| Covid Vaccination Service | Pharmacy Income | 3 rd October | The Autumn campaign starts. Frontline Healthcare workers are included, staff can also book in for a covid vaccination. Book here | |
| Local Services | Pharmacy Income | 5 th October | Please claim all your locally commissioned services and advanced services. | |
| SCAS 111 Referral Focus Weekend | Pharmacy Income | 5 th – 6 th October | 111 (Hampshire) supported by Pharmacists will be running an exercise to increase Community Pharmacy referrals. More information here | |

| Pharmacy NHS mailbox | Information & Support | Now | Make sure at least 2 staff have linked NHS emails to your pharmacy shared NHS Mailbox. How to information here. | |
| PharmOutcomes Access | Information & Support | Now | Check that pharmacy staff have access to PharmOutcomes during all opening times, especially when locums are on duty; set-up additional accounts if needed. Instructions can be found here . Ensure PharmOutcomes is checked regularly throughout the day and action any referrals received. | |

| Check NHS Shared Mailbox | Pharmacy Business | Twice a day (minimum) | NHSE&I and CPHIOW regularly send important communications to your NHS Shared Mailbox. Please ensure sufficient staff have access your Mailbox and that it is checked at least twice a day. | |
| Online Profile Update using NHS Profile Manager | Contractual | Quarterly | Using the NHS Profile Manager, ensure your Directory of Services (DoS) and NHS website pharmacy profiles are up to date. This needs to be verified each quarter. Remember to update your profile if you have to temporarily close the pharmacy during its normal hours. | |
| Local Services | Pharmacy Income | By the 5 th of each month | Please claim all your locally commissioned services. | |
| Virtual Outcomes | Workforce Training | Ongoing | Available free of charge to all community pharmacy staff. Access here . Latest modules: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Flu vaccination • Equality Act and MCAs • Common Skin Conditions: Psoriasis | |
| LPC Mailing List | Pharmacy Mailing List | Ongoing | Encourage locums to join the LPC mailing list to ensure they are up to date with changes. Visit LPC website for sign up. | |
