

## Training Requirements

To deliver this service, the pharmacist should have evidence of competence in the clinical skills and knowledge covered in the following training modules on the Centre for Pharmacy Postgraduate Education (CPPE) and/or the Health Education England e-learning for healthcare (elfh) websites:

1. CPPE Emergency contraception e-assessment (study time 3 hrs)
2. CPPE contraception including contraception e-assessment (study time 6 hrs)  
**OR** the following four subsections of module 3 – Contraceptive Choices of the FSRH Sexual and Reproductive Health e-learning (e-SRH) on elfh:
  - 03\_01: Mechanism of action, effectiveness and UKMEC;
  - 03\_02: Choosing contraceptive methods;
  - 03\_03: Combined hormonal contraception; and
  - 03\_04: Progestogen only methods (oral and injectable).
3. CPPE consultation skills for pharmacy practice and e-assessment (study time 10 hrs)
4. CPPE Sexual health in pharmacies and e-assessment (study time 6 hrs)  
**OR** the following four subsections of module 9 – STIs of the FSRH e-SRH22 on elfh:
  - 09\_01: Epidemiology and transmission of STIs;
  - 09\_02: Sexually transmitted infection (STI) testing;
  - 09\_03: STI management; and
  - 09\_04: Partner notification.
