

Considering organising an MDS compliance aid for a patient?

This list gives some suggestions about the patient aids available and where you can get them. This may enable patients or their relatives to manage their medicines without the need for a Monitored Dosage System (MDS).

Before supplying an MDS, you may want to:

- Ensure a medicines review has been undertaken and the regimen simplified.
- Consider if a relative/informal carer who lives with the patient can help open bottles.
- Consider medication reminder charts and administration charts.
- Would a patient aid help? E.g. colour coding, setting alarm clocks, posters in prominent places such as on the fridge or by the sink.
- A relative/informal carer may be happy to fill a weekly calendar box.

There are a lot more aids that can be used. The companies listed supply a number of products in addition to those shown.
