SEPSIS is a serious infection complication

- It can look like flu, gastroenteritis or a chest infection
- If left untreated, it can lead to multiple organ failure and death
- ! ¼ of all sepsis survivors suffer permanent life-changing after effects
- **!** 5 people are killed by sepsis every hour in the UK
- 25,000 children are affected by sepsis per year in the UK

HOW TO SPOT SYMPTOMS OF SEPSIS

<u>Call 999</u> or go to <u>A&E immediately</u> if any of the following

Child under 5 years	Any child	Any adult
Not feeding	Looks mottled, bluish or pale	S lurred speech or confusion
Vomiting repeatedly	Is very lethargic/ difficult to wake	Extreme shivering or muscle pain
Not passed urine for 12 hours	Feels abnormally cold to to	P assing no urine in a day
	Is breathing very fast	Severe breathlessness
	Has a rash that does not fade when you press it	It feels like you're going to die
	Has a 'fit' or convulsion	S kin mottled or discoloured
