

## History Taking and Assessment Short Course

Level 7 (postgraduate) 20 credits | Course fee £1,200

## Course Overview

This module is aimed at practising healthcare professionals who are in roles requiring, or that will require, advanced skills in history taking and assessment of patients, and is offered as a standalone Level 7 module. The course will cover not only physical assessment skills but a full range of assessments to assess patients mentally as well as physically.

Successful completion of this multidisciplinary module will enable students to develop the knowledge and clinical skills required to systematically take a patient history, perform physical examinations, and interpret diagnostic data. These skills are the foundations of Advanced Practitioner education and will facilitate the ability to assess and manage patients with undifferentiated and undiagnosed conditions.

The teaching will be delivered on campus at the University of Winchester.
